

**QUALIFYING FEES FOR COUNTY OFFICES
2018 ELECTIONS**

The Official Code of Georgia Annotated, Section 21-2-131, requires that the governing authority of Cobb County, not later than February 1 of any year in which a general primary, nonpartisan primary, or general election is to be held, fix and publish a qualifying fee for each County office to be filled in the upcoming primary or election. Therefore on January 9, 2018, the Board of Commissioners is scheduled to adopt the following proposed qualifying fees for the County offices to be filled in the May 22, 2018 primary or election. Said fees were determined as set forth in O.C.G.A. 21-2-131. Qualifying will take place March 5–9, 2018.
